

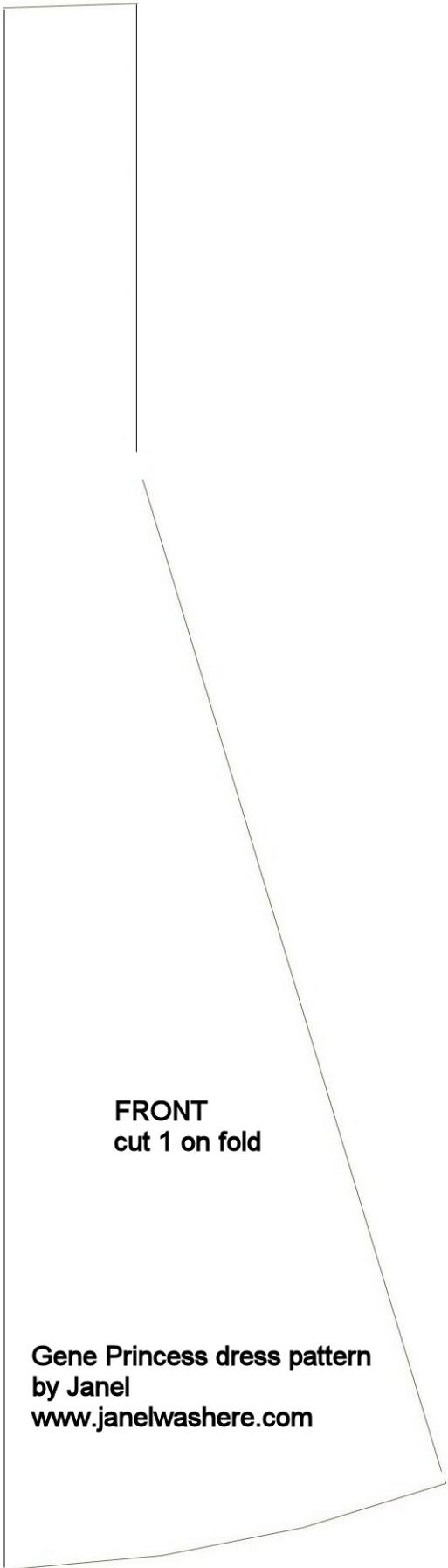

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Gene princess dress, really really basic instructions:

1/4 seams included.

Fold over the top edge of the front and stitch

Sew side fronts to fronts, being very careful to get both sides of the front at even heights. Clip curves to remove bulk

Sew backs to side backs and press the pieces so far.

Sew shoulder seams

Fold over neck edges to form a facing and stitch

Fold over and hem sleeves, then gather sleeve caps and sew onto dress. It takes lots of pins to get that lined up right.

With dress wrong sides together sew up the sleeve seams and down the side seams of the dress

Then make a hem.

Fold over back edges twice. Try on the doll for fit. Add snaps or velcro.
